All of lot (1) one less (3) acres right of way of Rail Road and lot (3) less three and ²⁵/₁₀₀ acres right of way of Rail Road and the undivided one half of lot (5) plus all the sections (6) six of Township (24) Twenty-four North of Range (6) six East.

To Have and to Hold, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto the said part *of* of the second part, and to *his* heirs and assigns forever.

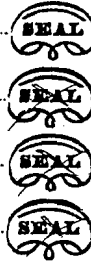

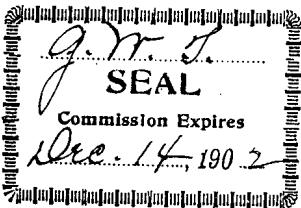
